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FOAM-RUBBER POOL FLOATABLES

Log Slice Floatable 36"x36"x6" Single Anchor-Point



FEATURES

- High-density closed-cell super bouyant foam-core
- Softflex watertight rubber shell encasing
- Fiberglass reinforced base for added strength
- Vibrant high-gloss flexible paints and clear coat
- Stainless steel base plate with easy clip cup anchor
- Impact attenuating protective surfaces and materials

INSTALLATION

With pool empty, attach one end of the tethering chain to the rod in the center of the pool cup anchor. Secure quick-link cup by fastening and tightening the threaded connector. Repeat this step by connecting the other end of the tethering chain to the base of float. With both ends of tethering chain linked and secured, fill pool.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Perform daily safety checks to ensure no damage before use.
- Remove from operation if tears, punctures, or damage occurs.
- Always use 2 or more people to carry, load, and transport floats.
- Do not roll, drag, or push floats on ground as this will scratch paint.
- When not in use, store floats in a clean dry place.
- Remove anchor chains before storing floatables.
- Only stack floats on flat surfaces to avoid impressions in rubber.
- If stacking multiple floats, stack top-to-top and bottom-to-bottom.
- Float tethering chains must be 6" greater than pool depth.
- Maintain 72" safety use zone around perimeter of floats.
- Remove float from pool when performing chemical treatments.
- Keep chlorine at 1-3 parts per mil with PH at 7.5 to prevent fading.
- Clean annually to remove any lime deposits from pool water.
- To clean, mix 1 tbsp 4% bleach per quart water.
- Using spray bottle, mist and wipe with clean soft cloth.
- Rinse and dry with soft towel.

GUIDELINES FOR USE

- Floating elements to be used by no more than a single person at a time.
- User maximum weight limit is 250 lbs.
- Users must be tall enough to reach overhead net as height requirement.
- Users must maintain engagement with netting at all times for balance and support.
- Users must be proficient swimmer capable of independent swim.
- No clothing to be worn with rivets, buckles, beads, clips, or other sharp/rigid materials that could scratch surface of floats.. This includes shoes, water-booties, jewelry, hats.
- All foreign objects must be emptied from pockets before use.
